

Spring Term Homework Project

As part of our science unit, Everyday Materials, we would like the children to design and create a room in a house using varied materials.

Learning Expectation:

To be able to identify and compare the uses of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard.

The children could be challenged to design and to make a room/toy house for a toy company. In order to sell the house, the toy company would like to know why the children choose the materials for the walls, windows, roof, etc.. Some of the model might have to be made with a particular material, but labelled to show what it would be in real life – e.g. the walls might be card, but labelled 'brick', etc.
