Magnificent Model Making

Research to find information about a famous Roman structure. Then recreate the building as a junk model. You could use cardboard to make it and paint it to make it look more realistic.









Budding Designers

Design and make an outfit for a Roman soldier or Roman gladiator. Bring it into school or take a picture of yourself wearing it.

Design and make a helmet or a shield for a soldier in the Roman army.








Create a Roman style mosaic. You could use squared coloured paper to look like small tiles, or create a square shaped paint stamp.

- Create a maths worksheet for a Roman child.
 Remember to use Roman numerals instead of numbers.
- Write a secret message using Roman Numerals (using an alphabet key).
- Create a game/board game for a Roman child.



Famous Romans:


Find out about a famous person from Roman times e.g. Julius Caesar. Create a simple fact file about their life. Maybe you could present your findings as a PowerPoint.
