What is European Day of Languages?

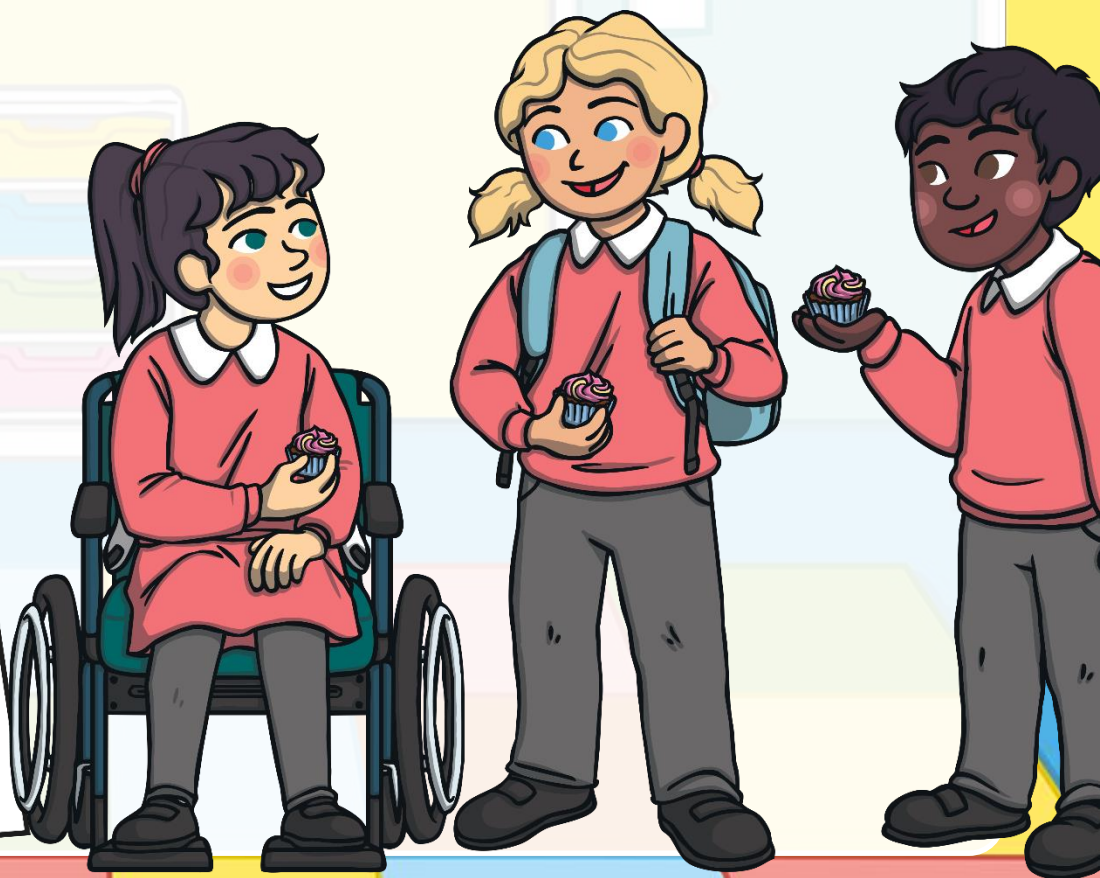
It is a day where we can celebrate the different languages spoken in Europe.

on the 26th of September each year.

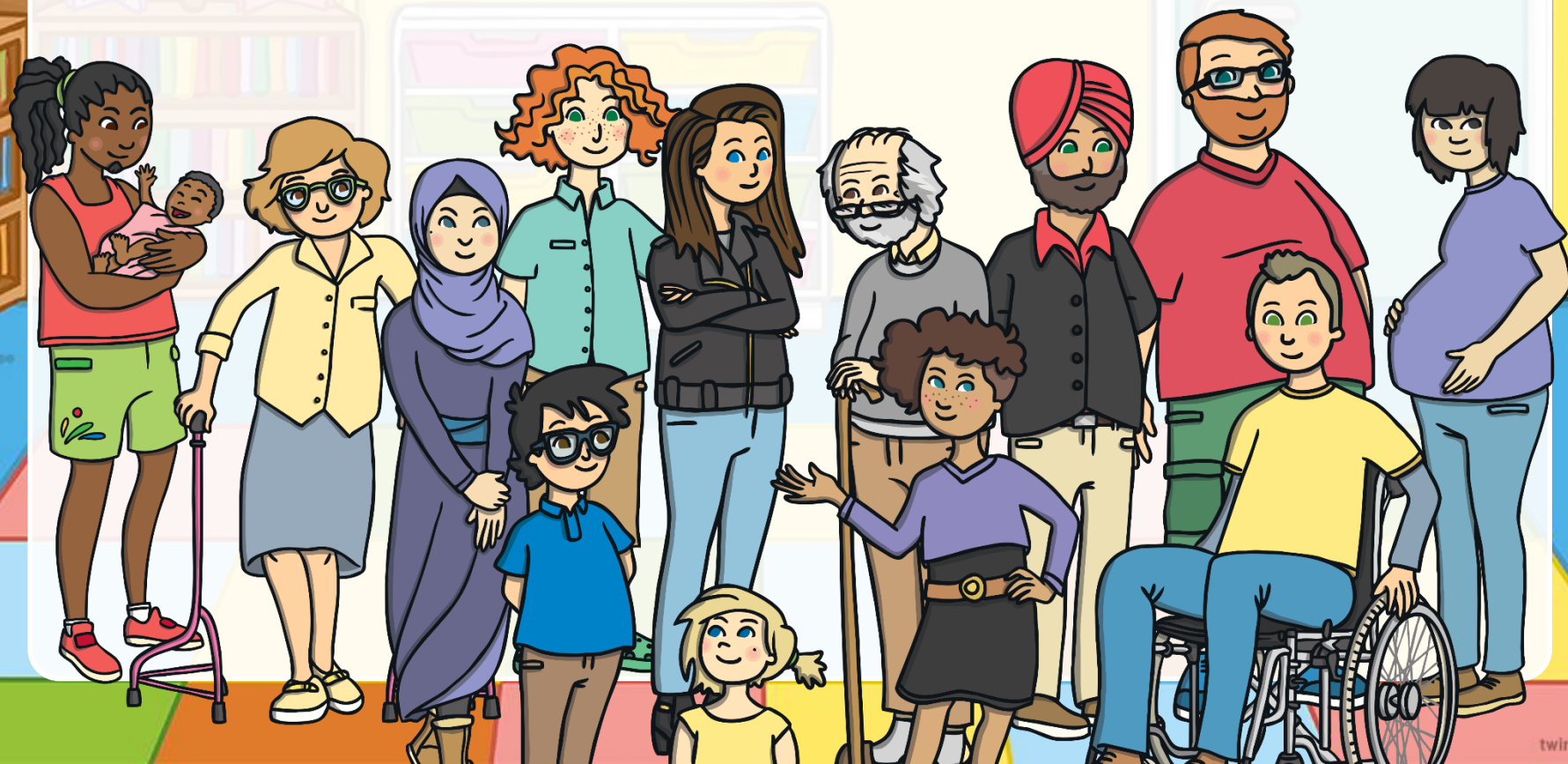
