





With the learning of reception children being disrupted, we've decided to put a bit more time early in Year 1 on numbers to 10, particularly around place value and the introduction to the concept of parts and wholes.

Devote more time to this block if needed before moving on and continue to revisit difficult concepts such as comparing numbers.
