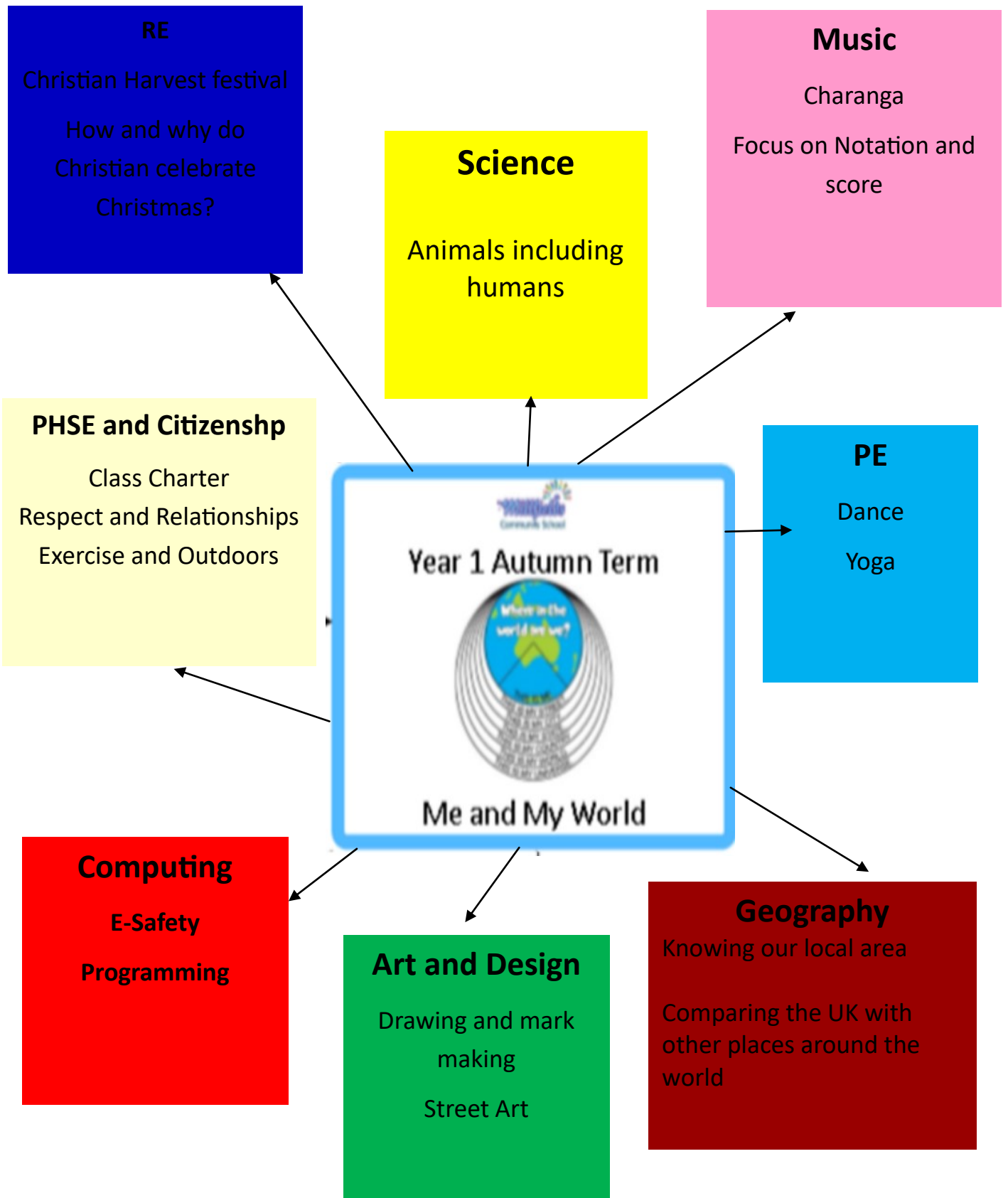
Home to school contact:
