All of the children did so well - they were focused after a school breakfast with their classmates, had a positive attitude and tried really hard. I was super impressed with the calmness and methodical way that the children approached the tests and was especially pleased to see that they had lots of strategies to rely on in the Maths papers. Well done everyone!

Nationally, it seems that children across

the country have found this year's test hard, and particularly the Reading paper, so our children have done really well! Thank you also to the parents who made a contribution towards a surprise pizza delivery for the children today! The children were very excited to spend some time in the park to unwind, and to avoid the rain then came back to school to have pizza! Next week we will continue with the curriculum as we still have a few more weeks of writing assignments that will count towards the end of Y6 assessment grades. We are also excited to start working on the Y6 Show! We are going to be working with professional actors and writing some of the final script but don't want to say too much as the children don't know what the show is yet! The dates for the shows are in the penultimate week of term in July: Monday 10th - Hawking, Tuesday 11th - Turing & Wednesday 12th - Anning. Y6 families - make sure the date is in your diary!

The Y2 children are still doing their SATS - Reading and Maths tests until the end of May, and they are also working very hard to show us what they have learnt! Keep going - you are all being superstars so far!

Also this week, and last week, the Reception classes visited the Hackney School of Food and learnt how to make dough and made their own pizzas! They also loved looking around the gardens, and saw the resident hens! Jones Class also visited Stepney City Farm as part of our continued work with the charity, Empathy Animals. During their visit they get to feed the animals, think about how animals feel and how they are treated as well as do some observational drawings. We hope that many more of our classes will have an opportunity to visit during the summer term and next academic year.

Well done to all the children who have been running before school every Tuesday, and running in their own time in preparation for the Hackney Run that is taking place next weekend. 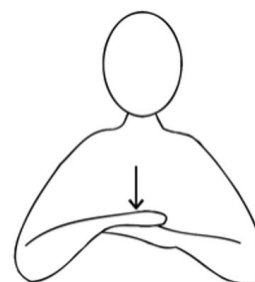

PSA After-school Tuck Shops — Summer 2023

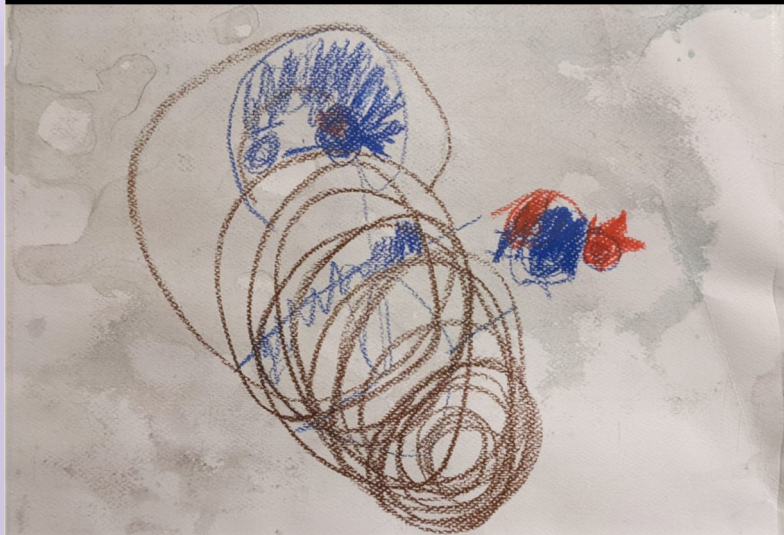

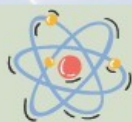
