It has been a very busy week again, especially on the sporting front. On Wednesday, our Y5 and Y6 swimmers took part in the Hackney inter-schools Swimming Gala. They did so well, and brought home 9 medals between them! The Y4 and Y5 football team played on Tuesday - they did so well as this is the first time they had played against other schools, and there are some definite future stars in there! Thank you to Sharon, Kea and Devon who supported the children at these events. As you know the

Cycling Team were in action last Friday, and although there were a few new riders, the team, as always all tried their very best. It was very competitive, so some great racing. We managed to take 4 medal places and lots of top 10 finishes, so another big points win for the league. They were all fantastic, and look like they have guaranteed the league title again this year - fingers crossed! Thanks to Anna's mum who volunteered on the day.

There have also been lots of trips as well this week! Year 4 have been out and about - they visited the Hackney Museum as part of their work on Windrush and spent time playing games in the local parks afterwards. Y4 have also been doing the national Multiplication Check Tests - well done to everyone so far! Berners-Lee and Macintosh classes visited the Natural History Museum to see the 'Earthquakes and Volcano Show'. They loved it and had lots of interesting facts to share, and asked lots of probing questions! Y1 children have also been doing the Phonics Screening Test - they have all tried so hard and we are pleased with the results so far!

Staff have also been busy preparing and facilitating a visit from our School Improvement Partner from Hackney Education. This visit is an opportunity for us to share all the great work that is happening every day at Millfields, and to share data on progress and attainment and an opportunity for our SIP to look around the school, observe teaching and learning, speak to children and staff, and look at children's books. We are also busy planning for activities before the end of the term including Democracy Week and Sports Week/Fortnight, as well as all the Y6 end of year activities. Sports day times are in the Mag and will be shared via email too. We will keep you posted with dates and times of all the other events. There is also the possibility of more school closures due to NEU strikes, so some dates may change. Please make sure to check the school website and read your texts. As always we will try to give you as much notice as possible in order for you to make alternative arrangements.

Just a reminder, that if your child is in the current Y2, Y3, Y4 or Y5, Musical Instrumental lessons are on offer and need to be booked and paid for by Friday 14th July at 5pm to secure a place for the Autumn term. Currently we offer guitar, drums, violin, trumpet, trombone, saxophone, clarinet, flute and piano tuition. The lessons take place weekly, during lesson times for 10 weeks each term. We have had lots of interest from our Y2 children, but a reminder that if your child is currently having lessons and you want to continue, then you do need to book as well! 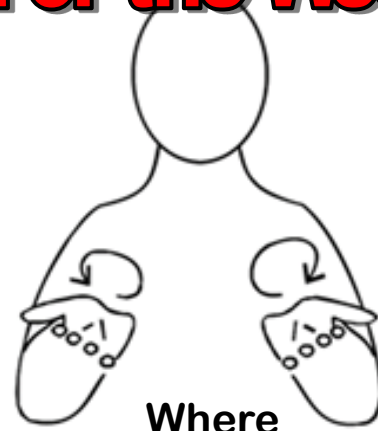

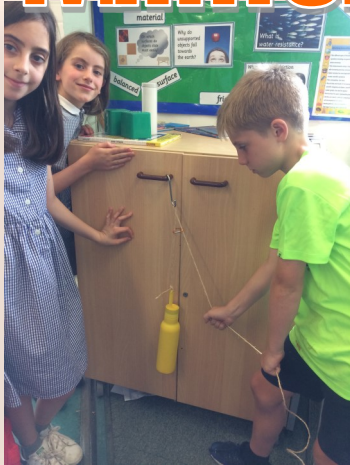

We would also like for parents to share their experiences of living with a child with ASD and for it to be the start of a regular support group for parents.



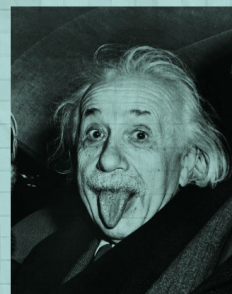

## Children & Family Hubs Consultation

**Give your feedback on Hackney Council's model for Children and Family Hubs.**

We are consulting on how we develop some of our existing children's centres into four Children and Family Hubs.

Hubs will offer support for families and young people aged 0 to 19 years old (up to 25 for young people with special educational needs and disabilities – SEND).

The hubs will bring together staff working across a range of different services, including the Council, health services and voluntary and community organisations.

The hubs will act as a 'one stop shop' to offer guidance and advice for families, including infant feeding, debt and welfare advice, mental health support, health services and family support.

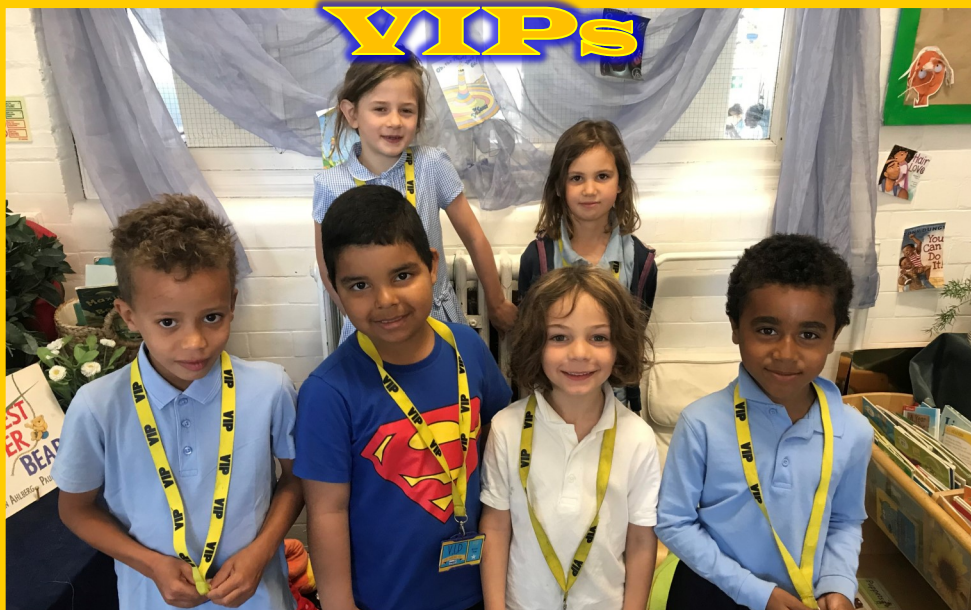
