Please read on for some important dates and information about your child's learning this term. On the next page you will see an outline of the learning that the classes will be covering in the Spring Term.

Core Subjects Overview

In **Maths** we will be learning strategies to solve multiplication and division problems. We will also learn about fractions, length and perimeter, and decimals. In **English**, we will be learning the skills needed to write diary entries, balanced arguments and adventure stories. In **Science** our topics are 'Sound' and 'Electricity'.

PE Times

PE for all classes is on Tuesday and Wednesday each week. Children should wear their PE kit (white top, navy bottoms and black shoes) to school on PE days.

Homework and Reading

All children should have a book bag. Reading books are changed on Tuesdays so please make sure books are returned by **Tuesday** morning each week. Homework will be sent via Google Classroom each **Friday**. This will include spellings, Times Tables Rock Stars and times tables practice. Children will also receive a project linked to their topic each term. We appreciate your support in encouraging your child to complete their homework.
