Core subjects overview:

In **Maths**, we will continue to learn about multiplication, division, and move on from our learning about fractions in the Autumn term. We will cover our first unit for year 5 in decimals and percentages as well as complete learning about perimeter area and statistics.

In **English**, we will be studying a number of genres that link to our topic. We have begun our term reading Flooded by Marcus Sedgwick and will use this text as inspiration to write a narrative. Across the term we will read: Our House is on fire by Jeanette Winter as well as Hot like Fire by Valerie Bloom, Flood by Alvaro F. Villa and Skellig by David Almond. We will write a variety of text types from explanation, to non-chronological report, recounts and narratives of many kinds. We have a lot of great English ahead of us!


