Dear Parents and Carers,

Sadly, this is the last term at Millfields! Please read below for some important information regarding your child's class as well as an outline of the learning that the classes will be covering in the Summer Term.

Core Subjects Overview

In the first few weeks of the term we will be concentrating on revision and practice work for SATs Maths, Reading and Spelling and punctuation. We will continue to do some foundation work in between. We will then continue with our work on writing and the Ancient Greeks before starting work on the Y6 Show.

The SATs take place in the week beginning 8th May.

Tuesday 9th May: English grammar, punctuation and spelling (Paper 1 & 2)

Wednesday 10th May: English Reading Paper

Thursday 11th May: Maths Paper 1 Arithmetic, Paper 2 Reasoning

Friday 12th May: Maths Paper 3 Reasoning
