Core Subjects Overview

In **Maths** we will continue to focus on Fractions before moving on to Converting Units, Ratio, Algebra, Decimals, Fractions decimals and percentages, Area perimeter and volume and Statistics. In **English**, we will be reading a variety of texts written or set in the Victorian era including Oliver Twist, Street Child and The Highwayman. We will learn the skills needed to help us write narrative stories, poetry, non-chronological reports, comparative judgements and diary entries.
