This will be a sharing event to celebrate Black History Month and an opportunity for you to look at the work from classes during BHM. This will also be an outdoor event for the whole school community, when we will ask you to bring a dish to share and enjoy with everyone, whilst listening to the brilliant steel pan musicians.
