Assemblies this week focussed on Black History Month. The aims of the planned learning, workshops in school, visits to the Hackney Museum, and texts read in class, are to promote positive role models, celebrate achievements, highlight contributions of Black people to society and inspire our whole school community. This year the theme is 'Saluting our Sisters'. Each year's group will research the lives and achievements of the following people. See if you can find out anything about the woman that your year group is studying.

Nursery - Claudia Jones (Journalist, Activist and 'Mother of the Notting Hill Carnival)

Reception - Floella Benjamin (actress, singer, presenter, author and politician)

Year 1- Veronica Ryan (Sculptor and winner of the Turner Prize)

Year 2 - Janet Kay (Vocalist, Actress, Lovers Rock Genre - Black British romantic reggae)

Year 3 - Dr Anne-Marie Imafidon (Computer Scientist, 'Stemettes', Youngest female ever to pass A-level computing at age 11 and passed two GCSEs in primary school!)

Year 4 - Margaret Busby (Publisher, editor, writer, broadcaster, Booker Prize Judge, UK's youngest publisher)

Year 5 - Una Marson (Activist, writer, poet, playwright, presenter, First Black woman employed by the BBC)

Year 6 - Fanny Eaton (model, domestic worker, Art/ Portraits -changed perceptions of beauty) The work from the whole month will help create a showcase and display in school that will be shared with the school community at our celebration event on Wednesday 1st November. There will be Steel Pan Music & Choir, Food, Display of learning outcomes, photos, pupil voice, writing samples and homework projects displayed and maybe even a fashion parade! Save the date! Look out for more information about the homework project - create a poster celebrating your Black History Hero.


Please talk to your children about their learning, and we will keep you updated with what has been happening in school. Finally on Friday 20th October, the children are invited to wear red to school that day to support 'Show Racism the Red Card'.

A big 'well done' to Yangtze Class and Orinoco class who shared their learning so far this term in assembly today. The children in Y4 looked fantastic in their Egyptian-themed costumes, they had learnt all their lines well and both classes sang beautifully.

Finally, yesterday was E-safety day at Millfields. All the classes took part in lessons in class that reminded them about the amazing resource that the internet can be, but also about the dangers and the things to be aware of when using any form of online game, accessing social media or looking at websites. The children all took part in an e-safety lesson, and then signed an individual Acceptable Use Agreement. The important message is that children need to be aware that there could be a danger, and know to always ask an adult if something does not look right or they are unsure, and to know that they should not click on anything without checking first. Please talk to your child about staying safe on the internet and be aware of your responsibility as a parent/carer to guide your child and not allow access to sites/ media that is for an older age group. 


