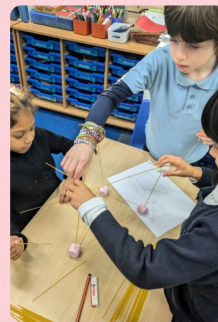
# Millfields Life in Pictures
