Also this week, members of SLT have been in classes observing teaching and learning, talking to children about their learning and teachers about the impact their planning and adaptations had on each child's progress. One thing shines through; all the children at Millfields 'Love to Learn' (This is one of our core values!). The children were able to tell us what they learnt during the lesson, in previous lessons and in lessons last year. There are a few more observations next week, and Autumn term assessments in classes from Year 1 to Year 6 start on Monday 2nd December.

Our first festive event is the Christmas Fair that will take place on Friday 6th December.
