Core Subjects Overview

In **Maths** we will be learning Multiplication and division and fractions in the first half term. In the second half term we will learn about position and direction, place value, money and time. In **English**, we will learn the skills needed to help us write poems, newspaper reports, diary entries and information text. In **Science**, we will look at plants, growing and cooking. We also go to forest school and look at seasonal change.
