Core Subjects Overview

In **math**, we will be learning about fractions. Time, length, and height for the first half term. In the second half of the term, we will learn about position and direction, mass, temperature, and capacity. We will continue to learn and revise the 2, 5, and 10-times tables. In **English**, we will learn the skills needed to help us write adventure stories, instructions, and descriptive recounts. In **science**, we will be learning more about Plants, growing up and wildlife.
