Welcome back!

Please read on for some important dates and information about your child's learning this term. On the next page you will see an outline of the learning that the classes will be covering in the Summer Term.

Core Subjects Overview

In **Maths** we will be learning about fractions, money and time for the first half term. In the second half term we will learn about shape and statistics. We will continue to learn and revise the 3-, 4- and 8-times tables. In **English**, we will learn the skills needed to help us write adventure stories, newspaper reports and descriptive recounts. In **Science**, we will learn about plants, forces and magnets and sustainability.


