Core Subjects Overview

In the first few weeks of the term, we will be concentrating on revision and practice work for SATs Maths, Reading and Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation. We will continue to do some foundation work in between. We will then continue with our work on writing and the Ancient Greeks before starting work on the Year 6 Show.

The SATs take place in the week beginning 12th May.

Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing their PE kit (white top, navy/black bottoms and trainers) on PE days and bear in mind that most PE sessions will be outside.

Spellings will be sent out in Homework books each **Friday**. Spelling checks will happen on the following Friday. Please support your child to practise at home. We also ask that children complete Times Table Rockstars daily to support their knowledge of times tables recall.

An ongoing project linked to The Ancient Greeks will be sent out via Google Classroom. Please encourage your child to read regularly and bring their book to school daily. We check in with children's reading during levelled reading sessions in class.
