The children have all been working hard and been very busy as usual in class and around school and the wider community. Reception classes visited the Space Gallery in the Science Museum and Y1 classes visited Stepney City Farm this week as part of their Science work this term on animals. They managed to dodge the rain and enjoyed learning more about animals in a Workshop 'Introduction to Farm animals'. They were all really excited to tell me about what they had seen and the animals that they were allowed to touch!

Y6 has been reading and researching life in Victorian times and Y5 have continued their work on 'Our Changing World' including coastal erosion. Y3 classes are really enjoying finding out about the Romans in their reading lessons and history lessons, and Y4 are learning all about Spain as a contrasting European country. Y4 also went on a local walk this week to look at religious buildings in our community and Mekong Class visited Cardinal Pole Secondary School to take part in a DT lesson - they made great keyrings to take home. There will be other trips and workshops to enhance Science and Humanities learning in all year groups over the next couple of weeks so please look out for information on Google Classroom and via email.
