Time is flying at Millfields



We are at the end of week 5 already this academic year, and the children and staff have been as busy as ever! This week, children started reading books in class and during their English lessons that celebrate and promote our learning about black history as part of the Black History season that extends throughout October. Yesterday was National Poetry Day and we marked this special day by studying specific poets and their poems. Children across the school read and ap-

preciated poems from a range of poets including Valerie Bloom, Grace Nichols, and Benjamin Zephaniah. The children read poems, had poems read to them, wrote their own poems and some even performed their own poems. They have made some lovely pieces of poetry artwork raising the profile of amazing poets as part of our Black History Month season. The work from the whole month will help create a showcase and display in school that will be shared with the school community at our Black History celebration event on Wednesday 22nd October. There will be music & choir, food, displays of learning outcomes, photos pupil voice, writing samples and homework projects displayed and hopefully some poetry performances. Save the date! Look out for more information about the homework project in the next few weeks. Then on Friday 24th October, the children are invited to wear red to school that day to support 'Show Racism the Red Card'. A big 'well done' to Orinoco Class and Mississippi Class who shared their learning so far this term in assembly today. The children in Orinoco Class had learnt so much about the Amazon and rain forests, as well as singing a beautiful song about saving the earth. Mississippi Class shared their learning about their time at Millfields. It was a real tear-ierker. Thank you to all the parents who came along to support their child. Also this week, Year 4 classes visited the British Museum as part of their work on Egypt. They enjoyed seeing and reading about the exhibits, and have already started to use their experience and learning in class. Finally, vesterday was E-safety day at Millfields. All the children were reminded about the amazing resource that the internet can be, but also about the dangers and the things to be aware of when using any form of online game, accessing social media or looking at websites. The children and staff will all be asked to sign an individual Acceptable Use Agreement over the next week. Some of you will see this on your Google Classroom. The important message is that children need to be aware that there could be a danger, and know to always ask an adult if something does not look right or they are unsure, and to know that they should not click on anything without checking first. Please talk to your child about staying safe on the internet and be aware of your responsibility as a parent/carer to guide your child and not allow access to sites/media that is for an older age group. Thank you to all the parents and children who visited our Eco Refill Shop today and also to all the fami-

lies involved every week with the Cake Sale. The proceeds help the PSA to help the school with much-needed resources. Thank you. You will also have received an email about Festive card designs.
