

## Spring Term 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back! Please read on for some important dates and information about your child's learning this term. On the next page you will see an outline of the learning that the classes will be covering in the Spring Term.

### **Core subjects overview:**

In **Maths**, we will continue to learn about multiplication, division, and move on from our learning about fractions in the Autumn term. We will cover our first unit for year 5 in decimals and percentages as well as complete learning about perimeter area and statistics.

In **English**, we will be studying a number of genres that link to our topic. We have begun our term reading *Flooded* by Marcus Sedgwick and will use this text as inspiration to write a narrative. Across the term we will read: *Our House is on fire* by Jeanette Winter as, *Flood* by Alvaro F. Villa and *Skellig* by David Almond. We will write a variety of text types from explanation, to non-chronological reports, recounts and narratives of many kinds. We have a lot of great English ahead of us!

### **PE Times:**

**All of year 5 have PE on TUESDAY and WEDNESDAY.**

Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing their PE kit (*white top, navy/black bottoms and trainers*) on PE days and bear in mind that most PE sessions will be outside. *Please do check Google Classroom as at times these sessions may need to change.*

This will include spellings, Maths Sheets and Times Tables Rock Stars times tables practice. Children will also receive a project linked to their Geography each term. We would appreciate your support in encouraging your child to read and complete their homework.

### **Term dates:**


