# Millfields Community School Positive Behaviour Management

## Millfields smiley face points system

During the term, children will be able to earn points through work and behaviour. Teachers will keep running records of points with the top 3 point scorers receiving a treat at the end of the half term (Trip, in-school treat) Points will be totalled at the end of each day allowing children to move up and down the system accordingly.

## Always Good Trip

During the term, children who persistently produce good work and maintain positive attitude in all areas are recognised by class teachers (this is separate to the top 3 points achievers) and go on a trip or receive a special treat as recognition of hard work. This will take place half termly.

At the beginning of each day pupils on the sad faces return to 'home' for a fresh start. Pupils on happy faces remain and try to get to 3 happy faces before the next celebration assembly. After the assembly all pupils start again at 'home'.





## Reflection Room Expectations:

-No talking, sit quietly and patiently

-You will be allowed to read a book independently

-Listen to teacher's instructions at all times

-Sensible behaviour

Failure to comply will result in SLT removing pupil and triggering red disc protocols.

### **Reflection Sheets**

Whilst in the reflection room, children will be urged to reflection and consider their behaviour and its impact on themselves and others.

#### **Reflection Room**

If a child is sent to reflection room 5 times in one half term, an internal exclusion will be triggered. This process will then reset and begin again. Parents will be contacted.
