### What these results tell us:

In **Maths** the number of pupils reaching level 2 is in line with the national average. The number of pupils reaching level 3 (exceeding expected level) is slightly below the national average.

Our priority in 2012 was to increase the number of pupils who attained level 2b+. This is now in line with the national average. The number of pupils achieving level 2+ in now well in excess of the national average.

In **Writing** the number of pupils reaching level 2 (expected level) has increased by 2%. This is well above national averages. The number of pupils reaching level 2b+ continues to rise and is well above the national average.

In **Reading** the number of pupils reaching level 2 (expected level) has risen by 2%. The infant classes' timetables continue to allow 45 minutes extra time each day for reading and phonics.

Our target in 2013 will be to increase the number of level 3s achieved across the board.

### What these results tell us:

In **Maths** the number of pupils reaching level 4 (expected level) has fallen by 6%; this was predicted in the realistic targets set for this cohort. The number of pupils reaching level 5 (exceeding expected level) has increased by 6%. This demonstrates a continued upward trend. 4 of these pupils achieved level 6, above the national expectation for the end of year 9.

Our priority in 2012 was to further increase the number of pupils getting level 5.

In **English** the number of pupils reaching level 4 (expected level) has increased by 8%. This is above national averages and is a continuing upward trend.

The number of pupils reaching level 5 (exceeding expected level) has more than doubled. Our next step is to help prepare the pupils for the new grammar and punctuation test.

These results are very good and we would like to thank the staff for all of their hard work and dedication to raising standards.

The children have made excellent progress and are well prepared for secondary school.
