We have all really enjoyed learning about the world of work this week. As every year, the children and staff have embraced the spirit of Work Week and enjoyed learning about lots of different jobs from focussed trips, visitors, parent talks and workshops. A huge 'thank you' to all the parents, carers and grandparents who have been in to class this week to talk about their jobs, we really appreciate your time and support.

The Year 6 theme was enterprise, and groups have been preparing to face business dragons in the city next week. They have been very busy designing their own products, thinking about how to market them and how to make a profit! They will be visiting offices in the city next week to see if they can persuade our very own dragons to invest! Good luck to them all! Year 5 have been very excited to be designing their own clothing as part of their work on ethical fashion. This afternoon, they will be putting on a Fashion Show to showcase their designs. Year 4 have been looking at the use of numeracy and literacy skills in the work place. They visited a restaurant to see how the business runs and have been looking at how restaurants run as a business. Year 3 visited Kidzania today and have been looking at the skills and attributes needed for a range of different jobs so today's visit may well have them coming back enthusing about their future careers! They have also been learning about the value of money. Year 2 have enjoyed looking at the role of jobs in the local community, and as well as doing a walk around the area, also visited Homerton Fire Station. The children really enjoyed the whole experience. Year 1 have been looking at basic skills needed for a range of jobs and visited a local supermarket to see the many different jobs that are done there! Reception classes have been looking at jobs in the emergency services, and as well as a visit from the police and a paramedic, have been on a trip to the Fire Station. Finally, Nursery classes have also been very busy looking at a range of jobs and had visits from a builder, gardener, vet and chef and visited Hackney City Farm to see the work that goes on there. It has been fantastic to hear the children talking about the work in school this week, so please do take time to ask them about it this weekend.

Also this week, the Book Fair arrived, so I hope you have had a chance to look at the great range of books on offer. The more money the Book Fair makes, the more free books the school can choose to stock the library shelves! It will be open during Parents Evening, Wednesday 15th November. Thanks for your support.
