A belated 'Welcome Back' to all our wonderful Millfields families and welcome to our new families who have joined the Millfields' community this term. A special welcome to all our new Reception class children and parents/carers and other new starters throughout the school. From next week, we will start encouraging the Reception children to come in and go straight to their classes. I know it may seem a bit daunting for the children (and you!) but they will soon settle and get the hang of all the school routines. So, from Monday, please leave your child at the main gate and allow them to walk down to the reception playground themselves. Please talk to your child about this over the weekend to ensure they know the expectations. In class, the children and staff have already been very busy getting back to the daily routines, setting new expectations and working hard. Thank you for ensuring that your children are wearing the correct uniform and shoes. If your child has not got black/navy blue shoes or trainers, please can you make sure they have them ASAP. Most importantly, you will hopefully have heard your children talking about our revised Behaviour Policy. We have introduced new rewards for individuals and the whole class, as well as consequences, which are working really well so far, but mainly we have reinforced the behaviour expectations, to be READY, RESPECTFUL and SAFE at all times. Part of the policy is to continually remind the children about zones of regulation to help keep them calm and in control of their emotions in order to learn. Please talk to your child about their new class routines and expectations in class and around school. We will be sharing the revised Behaviour Policy with you in the next few weeks as we are trialling and testing lots of things and want it to be meaningful, manageable and right before we send it out and put on the school website. The Parent Information Booklets will be sent home for classes in Y1 -Y6 today, but a reminder that PE lessons will start next week, so please ask your child which day they have PE and send your child into school wearing their PE kits on those days that their class has PE. Please note that football shirts should not be worn, so please wear a blue or white t-shirt and dark shorts, and black or dark coloured trainers. All of the classes have also been electing their Champions and Councillors. Every year, classes choose an Eco, Language, Reading and Equality Champion and 2 x Class Councillors. These groups ensure that all classes have a say through their reps on the things that happen at school. We also appointed all our Cabinet Members this week, and they will be introducing themselves to all the children, with the Prime Minister: Inayah, in assemblies next week. Thank you to the parents who attended the 'Welcome Meetings' this week; and there will be more taking place next week. We hope to see lots of you there at 4pm on your given day. If you cannot attend, we will email out the PowerPoint with all the information after the event. The main form of communication will be via Google classroom, email via SCOPay and texts, so please make sure we have the correct email and phone contact details. Parents in Reception and Nursery classes, please look out for joining details that will also be emailed out. But if there is anything else that you need to ask or want to know more about, please email the class teacher, Age-phase Leader or one of the Senior Leaders, and we will be happy to try our best to help! There is also lots of information emailed to parents and also text reminders, as well as lots of the information that you may need on the school website, which is regularly updated. As part of their learning each term, all classes will have a visit linked to their Humanities learning, and as many of you know, we have lots of other trips planned for throughout the year, so please complete the permission form within the Google Form on the link below to give permission for all London trips this academic year. We will also send this out via email to remind you to sign up, and to ask for a donation of £20-£50 per child to support the trips and workshops throughout the year. <https://forms.gle/pAAq79SvFPxCDbxf9> Today it was Outdoor Day at Millfields! All classes Y1-Y6 enjoyed a lovely morning out at Hackney Marshes. They were playing cooperation games, trust games, time trials, den-building, creating nature art and lots more, as well as a taking part in a PE lesson outside in the sunshine. A few reminders to look out for: the PSA Bake Sales every Friday that will be starting next week; and a reminder that we collect regular donations of non-perishable food for our weekly Food Bank - all donations gratefully received at the main office. Or you can also make a monetary donation - see Jane at the main gates. On **Wednesday 17th September**, we have professional photographers in school to take individual school photos. On this day, please wear your best school uniform, and shoes even if it is PE, and bring PE clothes with you. Please remember that we need to be mindful and respectful of our school neighbours. Please do not allow your children to climb on, or sit on garden walls, and please minimise standing in groups on the road or on the street corners, and please do not lean up against cars that are parked there. Thank you in advance for your support with all of this. **IMPORTANT:** Please make sure we have the correct email contact details, and at least 2 in-service phone numbers - this is essential for safeguarding and emergency purposes. Thanks also, for your cooperation and understanding while we ensure that the very popular club lists are established and tried and tested routines are put back in place. We will continue to review and keep you informed of any changes, and strive to find the best solutions. I am aware that there was some disappointment about not getting the clubs that you wanted but we unfortunately have limited space on each day, and we have also introduced additional new and exciting clubs this year that we hope your child might enjoy. This year we are opening up the **school yard** for anyone without a front garden to sell from.

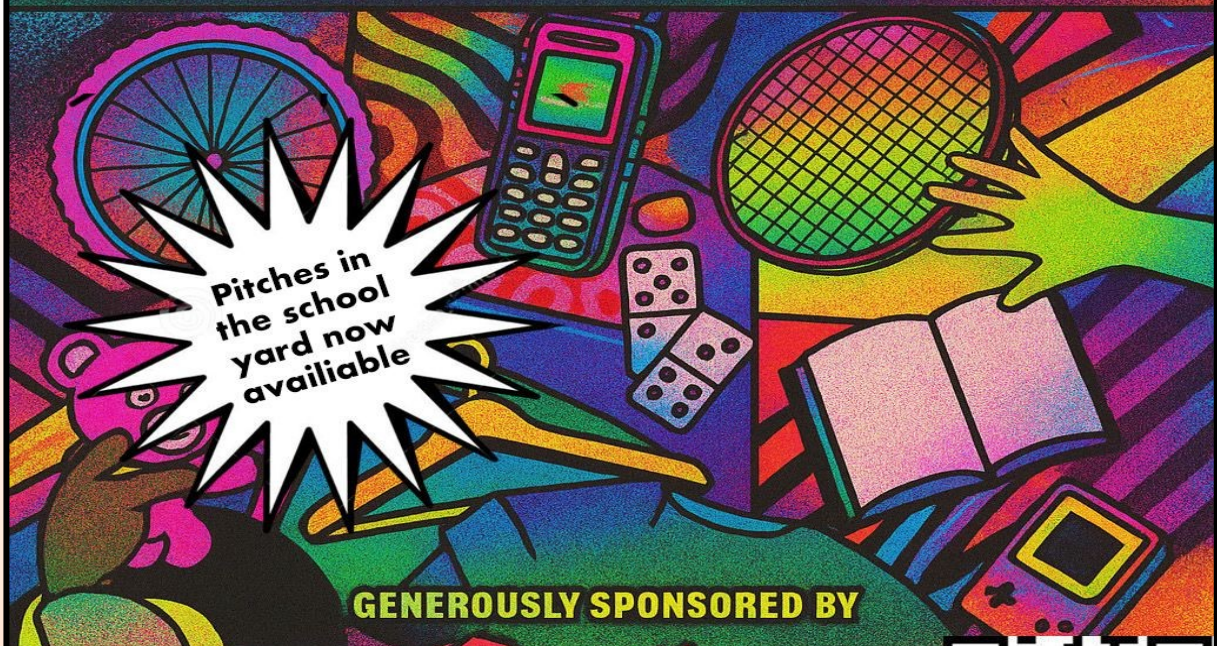
