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Ready for Half-term at Millfields

I cannot believe that we are at the end of this half term already and that means half way through the academic year! It has been a very busy one with Hispanic Week, Creative Week, Safer Internet Day, Workshops, trips and lots more!

The school has been filled with lots and lots of artists this week as all the children have enjoyed being part of 'Creative Week'. Every class has really embraced the theme - 'Robots' and have been thinking about how the world is changing through advances in technology, engineering, and artificial intelligence. Robots are increasingly used to help people in areas such as healthcare, transport, space exploration, and industry. Every child has created something that will contribute to the immersive art exhibition. There are some amazing creations, and I cannot wait to see all of this come together for our 'Creative Evening' on Wednesday 25th February from 4pm -7pm. Save the date! A HUGE THANK YOU to our Art Lead, Jess for planning and organising us all this week, and to all the staff who worked with the children to make this happen! And BIG thank you to you for all the junk materials and to the children's amazing creativity in imagining and producing some fantastic artwork.

Today is also Children's Mental Health Day, and the children have been immersed in the theme: 'This is my place'. Classes talked about belonging, about the feeling of being valued as part of a group and places that are important to them. They discussed that belonging to a group makes you feel cared for and comfortable to be yourself and the more places you belong, the more you feel valued and happy. All of the children made a personal island map, and were given the opportunity to share and explain their island to friends if they wanted. Also, all of the older children completed a well-being survey that we will look at after half term to address anything raised.

We also marked National 'Internet Safety Day' on Tuesday. This year's theme is 'Smart tech, safe choices – Exploring the safe and responsible use of AI'. Children were thinking about the increasing use of AI in our lives and were asked to think about what AI technologies are and where we might find them and also how to use AI technologies safely and responsibly. Please talk to your child about their learning and thoughts.

Thank you to all the parents who came in on Tuesday, to the Olive Dining Coffee morning and discussion around school food and the new school food policy. Thanks to Martin from Olive, and Parent Governor, Antonia for organising this session, and to all of you who contributed to the discussion. Look out for a questionnaire coming shortly and for more information about the School Food Policy.

On the sporting front, we took part in Hackney Schools Cycling League on Hackney Downs yesterday. The children from Y4 and Y5 involved did so well. We won the event overall and are now 100 points clear at the top of the league! Well done everyone, and thanks to Nishie, and Logan, and all the parents who came along to support.

Also this week, the children in Y6 visited The Ben Kinsella Trust - an anti knife crime charity that educates young people away from youth violence and campaigns to stop knife crime. 
