Yesterday was Transition morning for all of the children and staff. We welcomed new teachers -Fiona, Jade, Sheyenne, Jess and Clara to the Millfields staff team. We have also changed the names of our classes this year. All EYFS classes are named after British authors, KS1 classes are named after British artists, LKS2 classes are named after British inventors, and UKS2 classes are named after British Scientists. It is going to take all the staff and children some time to learn all the new names, but I hope that your child will have spoken to you about their class name and that you will help them research and find out more about their class namesakes over the holidays. I hope that your child enjoyed their morning with their new class teacher/s. It is always a difficult task to allocate teachers to classes each year and there are always many factors that my team and I have to consider when making this decision, factors that you may not be aware of as parents, but please be assured that the decisions are not taken lightly and much thought always goes in to the process to ensure the best outcomes both academically and socially, for all of the children in the class as a whole. The class allocations, with the new names can be found on the website under the parents information section. Support staff allocations have not yet been finalised, but we are confident that we can maintain the high ratio of pupil-staff next year despite the budget cuts. A list of all the school staff will be available on the school website for the beginning of the school year.

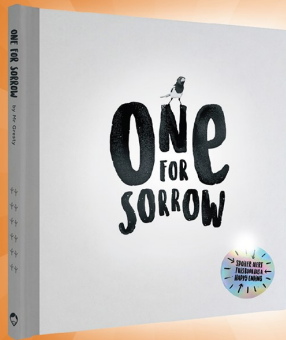
