We have such a wonderful school community who are always so generous and have continued through lockdown and this term to contribute to all the fundraising that we take part in. We raised a fantastic £450 for 'Show Racism the Red Card' at the end of last half term by wearing red and talking about the injustice and inequality in our world and how we can campaign and

fight to eradicate it.

A huge 'thank you' to the staff and parents/carers of Y1 and Y2 children who by taking part in the Poppy Run, raising £945 for the Poppy Appeal. On Wednesday 11th November, all of the children and staff marked Remembrance Day with a 2 minute silence at 11am. The children watched a recording of the Last Post in class and then came together in silence to remember those who lost their lives across the word. We have created a poppy display in the reception/office area of the school to remind us!

The children have been very busy in class again this week, and have been showing me lots of their fantastic learning. Reception children have been learning about shapes -they are pretty good I must say! They are also continuing to learn to write their names - please practise this at home and ask them about the names of the shapes they have learnt. Year 1 are learning about the wonderful city that we all live in - London. They created some lovely collage maps of the River Thames and drew some of the most famous landmarks. Hopefully, they may get to visit some of them later in the year - fingers crossed! Year 2 have been doing some tricky Maths this week - they are exchanging tens and ones and impressed me with their confidence.

Year 3, as you can see from the photos have really enjoyed learning about WW2 and this week, after taking about Ration Books and food shortages, made potato cakes in their class! Despite all the windows and doors being open, the fire alarm went off and we all evacuated the building – just in case! The children exited the building in a very orderly and calm way, so it was good to have another practice! Well done everyone! Year 4 continue daily to learn their multiplication tables, so test them at home too; Year 5 have been writing persuasive letters to the Mayor of Hackney about what they would like to see in the local parks; and Y6 have been debating and learning how to write a balanced argument. As always, I would like to thank all of you and all of the school staff who are continuing to follow local lockdown guidelines, and make life as 'normal' as possible for all the children at our school.
