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#### Millfields Musical Masters on Show



Firstly, well done to all the Year 6 children who completed their SATS this week. They all worked extremely hard and definitely tried their best. The tests were pretty tough, but they all made me feel very proud as they all worked determinedly on them each day this week. The Y2 children are still doing their tests until the end of May and are also working very hard to show us what they have learnt! Keep going!

This week, the 3 Reception classes enjoyed a trip to Sutton House to celebrate 50 years of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'. They had great fun retelling story and doing a bit of acting, as well as taking part in lots of activities around healthy eating, and story-telling.

On Tuesday, we had a visit from the DfE who were hosting a group of ministers, advisors, academics and teachers from Turkey. The Turkish Minister is currently looking to develop and improve his country's citizenship education curriculum for primary schools and is interested in how schools in England teach citizenship and democratic values to inform his reforms. We had been recommended to the DfE by the Association for the Teaching of Citizenship, and the delegation were keen to have a tour of the school, meet our children, and some of the staff and hear about our won citizenship and democracy, and about our status as a gold Unicef Rights Respecting School. The delegation was also very keen to find out more about strengthening community engagement and improving education experiences for disadvantaged and diverse pupil communities. Roz and some of our cabinet members, as well as a group of our Turkish-speaking children, presented an overview of all the work we do in terms of citizenship and pupil voice and participation, and then we toured the school. The feedback from the visit was overwhelmingly positive. In particular, the group of Turkish-speaking children who translated were amazing! Thank you and well done to all of them, and to Roz and the cabinet members who presented!

It is national Mental Health Week, and our Y5 classes took part in a workshop this morning to mark the occasion. We know that having lots of fresh air and time outside formal learning is good for all our well-being, so next Friday is our termly 'Outdoor Day' for the whole school -there are more details about our activities and arrangements on the poster inside the Mag.

We were treated to a host of piano recitals after school yesterday – we have so many children learning the piano and we never have enough time to fit everyone in to all our evening concerts so this was an opportunity for them to shine! Well done everyone and thank you to Tom and Roz for organising.

And... news just in –the tennis team have won the Hackney mini orange tournament that they took part in today! This means that we will now be representing Hackney in the London-wide tournament next half term. Well done everyone involved and especially to parents Elena, Monique and Guy who support and train the team!

Finally, it is the Hackney Run this Sunday, so good luck to all our runners -there are more that 160 children representing Millfields. They have been training every Tuesday and Thursday morning for the last few weeks and will run the final mile with hundreds of other runners at the weekend. There are lots of activities on offer throughout the day, so please come down and support us if you can!




