Firstly, thank you to everyone for dressing up in pyjamas and/or wearing spots today for Children in Need. It is an amazing effort from the staff and children, so thank you!

Secondly, another huge thank you to all the parents and carers who came to parents' Evening on Wednesday this week. We hope you found it useful to talk to your child's teacher and to see the work that they have been doing in Maths and English, and hopefully you talked about some areas that your child needs to work more on, with your support at home. Thank you also to all of you who completed one of our termly questionnaires. We really appreciate your feedback and do look at all your comments and try to think about how we can work together to address some of the points that you raise. We will be collating all the information and sharing the outcomes with you before the end of term, and we will also post it on the school website.

As you will hopefully know from your child, this week is Anti-bullying Week. The children have all been thinking about and talking about the language around bullying, and learning about how to deal with bullies in and out of school! Classes from Y1-Y6 took part in an Anti-bullying Roadshow called 'All different, all equal', earlier this week, that has hopefully helped children feel confident to speak up about bullying. Also, each class watched an Anti-bullying film that reinforced the messages about bullying that we have been teaching all week. Year 5 and Year 6 also took part in a virtual reality workshop around bullying. Then today, all the children have completed a questionnaire about bullying that will be collated over the coming weeks, and will give us more information about how safe children feel at school and which strategies they use to report bullies, and be kind to all children in our school and the wider community. Please talk to your children about all kinds of bullying, especially around cyber-bullying. There is a link on the main page of our website (Info bar on the right hand side called Internet safety) that takes you to a range of websites that you and your child can access around e-safety. Following on from Work Week, our Year 6 classes all visited offices in the city this week to present their inventions and ideas to a Dragon's Den. The children and staff said the whole experience was brilliant and has really enhanced the children's knowledge and understanding of how a small business might work. The dragons were very impressed with all the ideas and the quality of the preparation and presentations that were given. Good job Year 6!

As part of a special enrichment project, some of our Year 4 children visited Shoreditch Town Hall to take part in an immersive theatre experience called 'The boy, the bees and the blizzard'. The children had an amazing time and really enjoyed the experience.

Finally, yesterday, the Millfields Tennis team went to the ATP Tennis Finals at the O2—we saw Federer play and met Greg Rusedski! Lots of the staff and other spectators commented on how well-behaved our children were so well done—great ambassadors for our school!

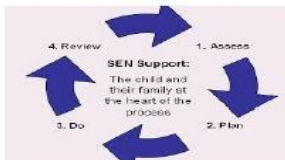
