These are typical of some of the regular spends the PSA makes. Beyond this we are working on a big project... the next and hopefully final phase of the playground development. We believe that together we can make that happen. You'll be hearing more about this early in 2026 when we'll also be holding discos for our older children, regular tuck shops plus much more!
