This year has started where we left off before the Christmas break, and our children are enjoying lots of additional learning opportunities to enrich the curriculum, including trips, workshops and special visitors to the school.

Despite the wet and windy weather, Year 2 classes visited Hampstead Heath to take part in an orienteering and map-work session, as part of their geography topic this term. The children really had great fun, learnt lots to bring back and use in school and really enjoyed being able to play in such a beautiful green setting!

Also this week, the children in Reception classes visited the Science Museum, as part of their wider curriculum work this term. The children were very curious, asked lots of questions and definitely learnt lots of new things.

The teachers held pupil progress meetings this week to look at and analyse the results of last terms' teacher assessments. As a result of these meetings, the staff have adapted planning, introduced new interventions and support, for individuals and groups, to ensure that each child is able to access learning appropriate to their ability and make good progress.

Thank you to all the parents and carers who attended the Year 6 Residential Information meeting this week. If you were unable to attend, please arrange to meet with Roz or one of the Year 6 teachers for further information. We also hope that the parents who attended the Sheffield Class Maths workshop found it useful – look out for more workshops in the future!

We are hoping that all the children will have seen the Hackney photo that all our work will be focussed around, so please talk about the photo that will be coming home with your child tonight. ## Millfields Community School

From **Thursday 1 February** Hilsea Street, Elmcroft Street and Rushmore Road between Hilsea St and Mayola Rd will become a pedestrian and cycle only zone.

### How does Hackney School Streets work?

- Hilsea Street, Elmcroft Street and Rushmore Road between Hilsea St and Mayola Rd will be made a pedestrian and cyclist only zone from 8.30am–9.15am and 3.15pm–4pm on school days only
- A pair of signs will be erected at the entrances to the zone warning drivers of restrictions ahead
- Access for residents and businesses will be maintained if they have registered their vehicle for an exemption
- Zone residents with vehicles in possession of a Zone N parking permit will be automatically registered; any other resident/business needs to apply for an exemption
- Special exemptions will also be granted to any blue badge holder and others, such as carers and medical staff
- Other vehicles driven by visitors, parents, delivery vehicles, Zone N permit holders living outside the school streets zone and school staff will not be permitted to enter the zone during the closure
- The zone is enforced by camera; non-registered vehicles entering the zone will be automatically issued a penalty charge notice
- All vehicles already within the zone during the operational times will be able to exit
