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Another Marvellous Millfields Week!

It is the end of what has been a great week of Maths - the school wide project focus was 'Building a Greener Future'. The aims of the week were to make Maths exciting, reinforce a growth mind-set, encourage mathematical thinking through context and problem solving, promote rich discussion using mathematical vocabulary, further develop investigation skills by allowing mistakes and exploration, foster a creative approach to problem solving, motivate collaboration, strengthen Maths learning behaviours and contextualise the importance of maths in the real world. Every day began with a Maths game. The children really enjoyed the games that are designed to be used across all ages and can be adapted or extended to meet every child's needs. If you would like to play some at home, you can find them on the White Rose website. All classes have also done 2 or 3 sessions on how Maths can help to build a better future.

In Nursery and Reception, the children have been sorting and counting shapes, and in particular, shapes that you see in nature. Y1 classes have been looking at patterns and shapes in nature, particularly learning about tessellations and fractals. Y2 has been learning about surveys - they went on a walk to Lower Clapton Road to count the different ways that people travel around, thinking about traffic and green transport in our community. They displayed the results in a pictogram. Scooters were very popular with children and adults! They also looked at how many cars were idling and which streets had more traffic. Y3 also looked at surveys and representing results, and were looking at 'Eco' approaches in school. For example, how much solar energy does the school generate? They surveyed use of lights and electronic whiteboards. Do all children have reusable plastic bottles? How many classrooms have plants to improve air quality? Y4 focussed on mass and capacity, again thinking about 'Eco' approaches in school by weighing waste versus recycling and then presented the findings and looked at how much food waste is produced at lunch time? Y5 worked on statistics and graphs and the 'Bigger Picture', including how the climate has changed in recent years. They collected and plotted data and presented findings in line graphs and then shared and presented their findings with other classes. Finally, Y6 were learning about coordinates, translations and reflections, as well as lines of symmetry, in order to design a new green space at school. There were some great ideas for developing existing areas and for brand new ideas like a green bridge. ALL of the children have been talking about their Maths work this week and have genuinely begun to make connections between the Maths they learn in school and the real world.



Another element of Maths Week was 'The Great Teacher Swap' that took place today. This involved the teachers in Y1-Y6 swapping classes and teaching a different class for one Maths investigation lesson today. The children and teachers loved it! We have also been learning about Maths Heroes, who we researched and then made a poster, leaflet, website or piece of artwork. We will be displaying some of this work on Archimedes, Muhammad ibn Musa al-Khwarizmi, Majorie Lee Browne, Ada Lovelace, Caroline Herschel and Alan Turing to name a few. Please ask your child about their learning this week!

Finally, a huge 'thank you' to Emily who planned and organised the whole week - a great week of learning was enjoyed by all!

Y4 classes also found time this week to visit the New West End Synagogue as part of their learning in RE. The children enjoyed the whole experience and now have lots of first hand background information to support their learning in future RE lessons.

Thank you to everyone who dressed up as Times table Rock Stars (or Pop Stars) today - what a brilliant effort from you all! The children looked fabulous and have been talking about their costumes all day! Thanks also for the donations for the tombola and for the £1 donations. Thank you also to all the Y5 and Y6 parents who came to the Welcome Meetings - the presentations will be shared with those who could not attend, and you can always check the website for more information on the curriculum for your child's year group. Also, thank you to the PSA for organising the Cake sales again! We made a record amount of money last week, and will be hoping for another successful sale today! Please make sure you check when it is your class' turn and help with donations or selling on the day. The PSA met this morning and has lots of events planned over the rest of this term and beyond, do look out for their emails and texts reminding you to get involved!


