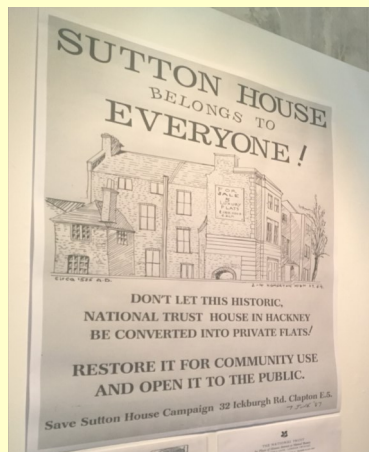
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Learning Champions Find Out About Activism at Sutton House

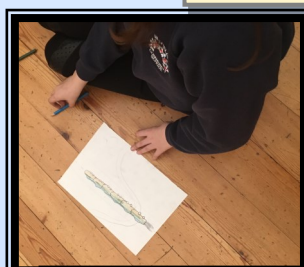
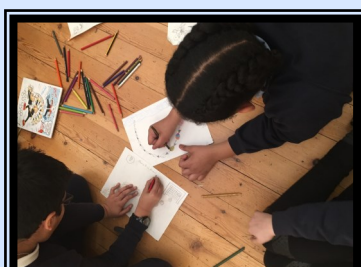

Well done to Millfields who finished as runners-up. It's the first time they have gotten so far in the competition!



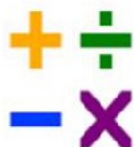

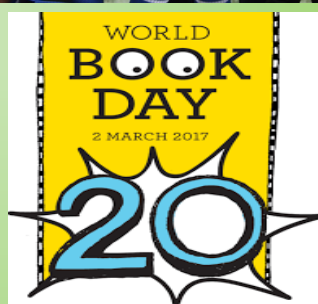
