We have had a busy week learning in class and out and about, as well as getting ready for Creative Week that is happening next week! Reception classes visited the V&A Museum and took part in a 'Discovering Shape' workshop. The session was set within the atmospheric China gallery, and encouraged the children to use imagination and experimentation to explore different shapes found in objects and spaces around the museum. Through this hands-on physical approach, the children made large shapes in groups, went on a treasure hunt around the gallery to find shapes hiding in the museum objects and then had a go at drawing their own shapes using coloured string inspired by some of the artwork and objects they had seen. The children really enjoyed their learning experience.

Well done to our Y4 and Y5 cyclists who won medals at the latest roller bike competition. We are currently trying to raise some funds for a couple of permanent roller-bikes in school so that the whole of KS2 can benefit from them as part of fitness sessions and PE lessons. 
