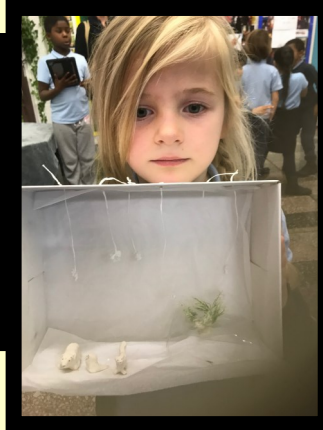
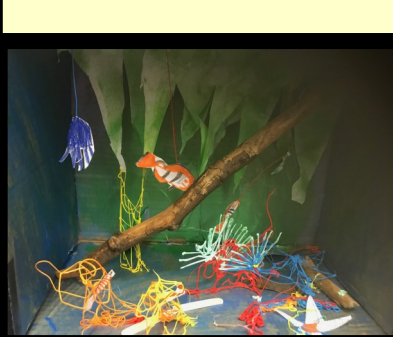
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What's in the box at Millfields?

The children in Nursery, reception, Year 1 and year 2 were all very excited on Tuesday as there was a special Owls visit. The children were treated to a demonstration in assemblies, and then each child had their photograph taken with the owl in their shoulder. They loved it! On Wednesday, children in Year 2 enjoyed a fantastic LSO performance of 'A Cat called Scratch' at the Barbican. The music was very engaging and the children all loved seeing the story they knew coming to life.

Also this week, the Senior leaders have been in all classes looking at the fantastic learning that is taking place and looking at the progress that all of your children are making across all areas of the curriculum. The children were all very excited to share their learning with us and the teachers have all had feedback to ensure that they continue to develop strategies and to ensure that the learning opportunities are always exciting, engaging and effective in moving the children on in their learning.

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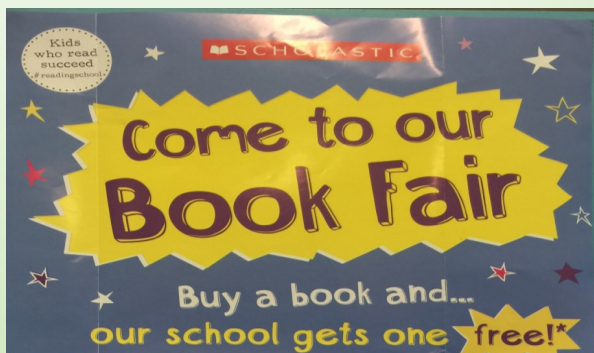
PSA After-school Tuck Shops — Autumn 2017
