There have been lots of very creative and imaginative art activities happening this week at Millfields! Creative Week activities have all focussed around what we think 'Future London' will be like. The week started with assemblies and presentations about the effects of global warming on London. Discussions included topics such as flooding and drought, the impact on food production, food chains and food prices, the global supply chain, energy blackouts as London is reliant on costal power stations, as well as increased air pollution.

Each year group was given a focus. The focus led each class debate and enabled innovative, creative and sustainable ideas for a future London. The work created in each class and year group for our future London is all made from recycled materials, particularly cardboard! Thank you for all your donations –we

are brimming with junk –card, paper and boxes that will be the basis of this year's art installation for Creative Night. The work created by each and every child includes lots and lots of pieces of art including junk modelling, sculptures, digital photos, films, paintings, collages and mosaics, which will be displayed for you all to see on 'Creative Evening' that takes place on Monday 28th January. Entry is by ticket only and there are 15 minutes time slots so that you are able to have the time and space to appreciate and immerse yourself in the Future London installation.

Tickets are on sale now from the main office –adults £1 and accompanied children are free. There are two sessions with limited tickets for each and they are selling fast! There will also be a selection of school meal dishes on sale -meat and veg curry, mac and cheese, chicken noodle stir fry and jerk chicken and rice. Or join us and eat in the bottom hall and be entertained by our choir and staff musicians as they sing some of London's famous songs! Thank you to all the parents and carers who have volunteered their time this week to support classes with their creative projects – your support is greatly appreciated.

We have also had international visitors to Millfields -teachers and leaders from Holland visited to look at the curriculum and inclusion. They thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity to speak to the children and staff about our school, and as always, I felt very proud of the enthusiasm and excitement with which they all spoke about their school.
