How to Order School Dinners

If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, they are entitled to Universal Free School Meals (UFSM) and you do not need to book this on SCOpay as this is only for paid meals. However, if you wish to book them in, to get used to using the system, then please feel free

If your child is in Nursery full time or Years 3-6, and they are not entitled to Free School Meals (FSM), and your child needs a school meal, then this should be booked and paid for on SCOpay.

You will not be able to book meals if you have a negative balance, so will need to clear your account of any debt before paying and ordering a school lunch for your child.

Meals can be ordered online up to 1 day before they are needed. You cannot book online on the day you need the school meal. However, you can pay for a school dinner and then let your child know to tell their teacher that they are having school dinners.

School meals do not need to be booked a week in advance, this is only for Breakfast and After School Clubs.
