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Getting Creative at Millfields



There have been lots of exciting and very messy workshops and art activities happening this week at Millfields! Creative Week activities have all focussed around celebrating Hackney and it's diverse communities. All of the work this week has been linked to one picture of Hackney that you will have seen on flyers and posters already. Each class has created pieces of art including junk modelling, sculptures, digital photos, films, paintings, collages and mosaics, which will be displayed for you all to see on 'Creative Evening' that takes place on Wednesday 31st January.

Tickets are on sale now from the main office –adults £2 and accompanied children are free. There are two sessions with limited tickets for each and they are selling fast! We are also asking parents to bring a favourite traditional dish to share on the evening –no nuts please! Please sign up at the main office. We are looking forward to seeing you there to enjoy the delicious food and appreciate the children's art work. Thank you to all the parents and carers who have volunteered their time this week to support classes with their creative projects – your support is greatly appreciated.

Also over the next few weeks, all of the classes will be visiting art galleries as part of their in-class learning about art techniques and artists; look out for the information letters coming soon.

In addition this week, Year 5 classes visited the Central Gurdwara as part of their RE work on Sikhism and year 1 classes visited East London Hindu temple as part of their RE topic work. These RE trips are a very important part of the children's learning and ensures that we are always learning and celebrating each other religions, traditions and culture. Each class visits one place of worship over the year as part of their RE work.

We have also had lots of international visitors to Millfields this week. On Wednesday we welcomed educators from Israel and China. Their visit to Millfields was part of an organised tour to look at inclusive education and see all our work on being a Rights Respecting School. Today we hosted teachers and leaders from Holland who were also interested in the curriculum and inclusion. They all thoroughly enjoyed the opportunities to speak to the children and staff about our school, and as always, I am very proud of them all!

Next week we have an open session on Wednesday 31st January on reading for parents of children in Reception and Year 1. The session is from 9.10am for about half an hour and we have 6 places in each class – please book via the main office. On Tuesday 6th February we have a parent workshop on e-safety and safer use of the internet – please put the date in your diary!

Millfields Community School

Tackling congestion at the school gates and improving the environment for walking and cycling to school.

From **Thursday 1 February** Hilsea Street, Elmcroft Street and Rushmore Road between Hilsea St and Mayola Rd will become a pedestrian and cycle only zone.

8.30am–9.15am and 3.15pm–4pm

How does Hackney School Streets work?

- > Hilsea Street, Elmcroft Street and Rushmore Road between Hilsea St and Mayola Rd will be made a pedestrian and cyclist only zone from **8.30am–9.15am** and **3.15pm–4pm** on school days only
- > A pair of signs will be erected at the entrances to the zone warning drivers of restrictions ahead
- > Access for residents and businesses will be maintained if they have registered their vehicle for an exemption
- > Zone residents with vehicles in possession of a Zone N parking permit will be automatically registered; any other resident/business needs to apply for an exemption
- > Special exemptions will also be granted to any blue badge holder and others, such as carers and medical staff
- > Other vehicles driven by visitors, parents, delivery vehicles, Zone N permit holders living outside the school streets zone and school staff will not be permitted to enter the zone during the closure
- > The zone is enforced by camera; non-registered vehicles entering the zone will be automatically issued a penalty charge notice
- > All vehicles already within the zone during the operational times will be able to exit
