It has been so hot this week -well done to all the children, and families, for being so flexible with the early finish and the relaxing of school uniform etc. as we have got through a very, very hot few days! Thank you for your support. Hopefully it is back to a more manageable heat and of course, we are back to the usual routines and timings.

It has been a real shame to miss out on some of the trips and events this week due to the extreme heat, so thank you again for understanding that the health and safety of the children and adults must come first. The Reception children missed taking part in the Hackney Music Festival this week, but we are hoping to have an opportunity to share the songs with parents before the end of term. Unfortunately we will not be able to reschedule the Y3 Bright Sparks trip which I know is disappointing for the children.

Well done to the KS2 Choir who managed to take part in the Hackney Singing Festival at the Round Chapel on Tuesday. There were fewer schools there, so the building was lovely and cool! The children sang so beautifully and I know the parents in the audience really enjoyed it! Thanks to Bruno for preparing the children and Tom for supporting them!

I cannot believe that we are getting closer and closer to the end of this academic year already - only 3 weeks to go, and there is still so much to do and so many events to organise and take part in! This week has been Assessment Week, so all the children in Y1-Y6 have been completing Maths and Reading texts, and completing a piece of writing. Alongside this, the teachers have been busy completing the end of year Annual Reports that will be emailed out at the end of the penultimate week of term - there will be a text to alert you when they have been sent.

Today, it was Transition morning for all of the children and staff. Children met their new teacher and the teacher met their new class. We welcomed lots of new children to the Nursery and Reception - lots of little brothers and sisters, as well as welcoming new teachers, Feryal and Will, for the Autumn term, to the Millfields staff team. All our classes are named after rivers and mountains from across the UK and the rest of the world, so it is going to take all the staff and children some time to match the teacher to the class names, but I hope that your child will have spoken to you about their class name and that you will help them research and find out more about their class names over the holidays.

It is always a difficult task to allocate teachers to classes and there are always many reasons that my team and I have to consider when making this decision, factors that you may not be aware of as parents, but please be assured that the decisions are not taken lightly and much thought always goes in to the process to ensure the best outcomes, both academically and socially, for all of the children in the class as a whole, and for all the classes across the school. The class allocations for the next year can be found on the website under the parents information section and here in the Mag. Support Staff allocations have not yet been finalised, but will be decided by the end of the year and shared in September. Look out for more information about the events taking place over the last few weeks of term: Sports Week including Sports Days (6<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup> July), the Y6 shows, and whole school London Day on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July, as well as the Summer Fair that is taking place on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July this year - save the date!
