Yesterday, the 'Always Good' winners from last half term visited 'Le Merlin' - a French creperie on Lower Clapton Road and were treated to some amazing crepes with lemon and sugar. We all agreed that they were delicious, and the staff were very friendly and helped us learn and speak some new French words too, as it is Millfields' language of the month for February. If you haven't already been, it's definitely worth a visit.

Also this week Reception classes visited The Look Out Discovery Centre in Hyde Park to take part in the 'Mission Invertebrate' session. The children learnt lots and were excellently behaved. Thank you to all the parents who volunteered their time to accompany the classes on their trip.

One of our Year 4 classes visited the 'Year 3 project' Steve McQueen Exhibition this week. The other 2 classes will be going on the next few weeks. You may remember that this was a London-wide project that was seen as one of the most ambitious portraits of children ever undertaken in the UK, explored through the vehicle of the traditional school class photograph. It offers a glimpse of the capital's future, a hopeful portrait of a generation to come!

Steve McQueen invited every Year 3 pupil in London to have their photograph taken by a team of specially trained Tate photographers. They included children from state primaries, independent schools, faith schools, special schools, pupil referral units and home-educated pupils. These class photos are brought together into a single large-scale installation, capturing tens of thousands of Year



3 pupils in a milestone year in their development. The children and the teacher that taught them in Y3 really enjoyed finding their photo in amongst so many! If you have a chance to visit, it is on at The Tate Britain until 3rd May.

Today, Lowry Class and Curie Class held their class sharing assemblies which were both great showcases for all the work that the children have been doing in class. Well done to each and every one of you, and thank you to all the parents, carers and grandparents who came to watch!

Finally, don't forget to start preparing your World Book Day costumes for Thursday. We

are asking children to dress up as your favourite book character who has either inspired you, made you laugh, made you think, made you change and mostly... a character or an author that MADE YOU LOVE READING! 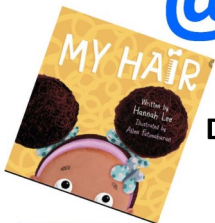
