Living and Learning at Millfields!

We have had another wonderful week of learning, despite the weather and the need for wet play earlier in the week! It is always quite tricky for many children to be inside all day, so we have tried to have some time outside even if it is slightly raining. And there have been so many exciting lessons and learning happening across the school.

The Nursery children have made kites and luckily we have had lots of wind this week, so they really enjoyed trying them out in the playground earlier this week. Reception classes have been learning about space, and have been reading books, painting and drawing, learning about planets, rockets, Martians and lots more. Shannon Class shared their learning in a lovely first Sharing Assembly this morning. Thank you to all the parents who came and for your support in getting the children ready. It was lovely to see and hear all the children confidently share what they have learnt with other EYFS children and their parents.

On Monday, Y5 and Y2 classes took part in fire safety workshops led by local Fire-Fighters. The children were really interested and learnt a lot. Thanks to LFB for their time. They In Geography, Year 5 classes have been learning more about the UK, especially about human and physical geography, the use of land and how this has changed over time. They did some research on the coastal town of Happisburgh. Y2 classes have been learning about Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole in History. Y1 classes have been finding out about the kind of toys that their parents might have used and have also been practising their acting skills as part of English work on the book 'Man on the Moon'. Yangtze Class in y4 visited Cardinal Pole Secondary School to take part in a DT workshop - they had a great time and brought back the keyrings they made. Well done Yangtze!

Thank you also to all the many Reception parents who attended the Reading session on Monday - we hope you found the session useful and that your child will benefit! Thank you to Sheyenne and Kimberlie for organising and sharing the resources we use in school. After half term, we will be asking parents to volunteer to read in Reception classes at the end of the day, so watch out for the email/on Google Classroom to sign up! Next week on Tuesday 3rd February, there is a meeting for Y1 parents about the Phonics screening check that takes place in June. Please look at your emails to sign up!

Again, thank you also to the parents who attended the Y4 Multiplication Tables Parent Information session on Tuesday. We hope you found it useful and that it will help you support your child to get ready for the tests that take place in June. Please look out for the Power-Point and other information via email for those who could not make it to the session. Thanks to Emma for organising.

Finally, some very exciting news for Fuji Class this week - they wrote letters to the King to tell him about their learning about the role of women in the Second World War and their assembly performance, and his office have written back to Fuji Class - you can see the letter, later in the Mag!
