I cannot believe that we are already in December! Christmas has already started at Millfields with choir carol singing -socially distanced and outside, class Winter Concert songs being recorded, and Y2 nativity lines are being learned! It is certainly not the traditional Christmas celebrations that we all look forward to every year at Millfields, but under the circumstances and keeping to guidelines on singing, social distancing and

This week, members of the choir have recorded Christmas carols to share at the Civic Service - the traditional Speaker's carol Service on Monday 7th December at 5pm. teaching at the best of times, but I know it is quite a challenge to keep all the children engaged all the time online! Thank you to some of the parents who contacted me with suggestions and further questions about the home learning expectations and experience.
