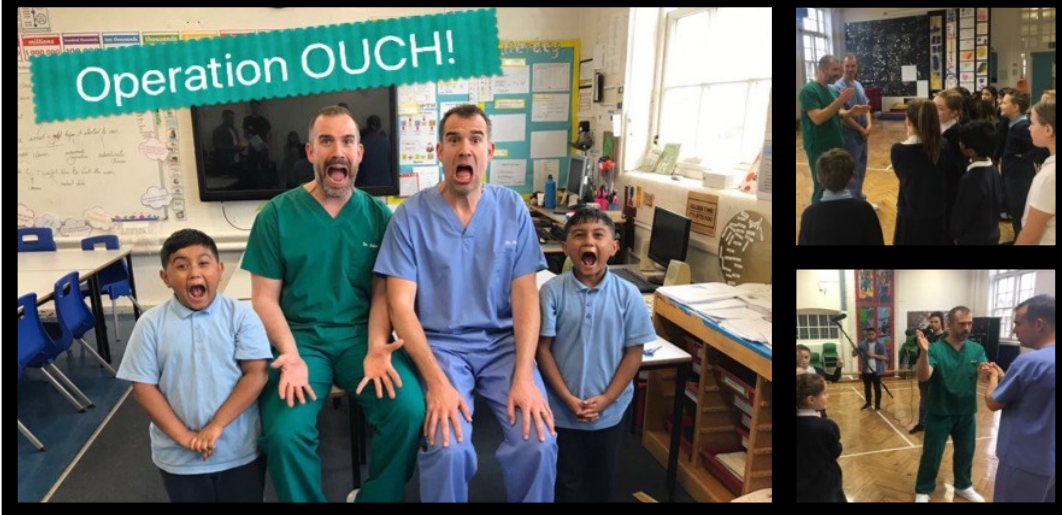

The 45 children who took part in the filming had a taste of what the whole process involved!
