It seems to have been a very long and busy week for us all, mainly due to the amount of rain and therefore 'Wet Play'! We really do try to get the children outside as much as possible but sometimes the weather is just too bad and we don't want the children getting soaked... a little bit of rain is okay but this means that your child needs to be wearing a waterproof coat please! Despite the rain, the children in class and around school have of course continued to have enriching and enjoyable learning experiences this week.

Firstly, a big 'well done' to both the girls and boys football teams who represented Millfields brilliantly in the 5 aside and 9 aside Hackney leagues. Thank you to Izaak for his support and organisation!

Annapurna Class visited Hampstead Heath as part of their Science work on rocks and soil - they enjoyed the workshop to find out more about soil and the environment. All Y3 classes also visited a local synagogue, and spoke with the Rabbi, as part of their Religion & World Views curriculum. Also, Y1 classes visited Bruce Grove Museum as part of their History work - looking at and finding out about how toys have changed since their grandparents' childhoods. They enjoyed the trip and learnt lots to write about back in school. Year 4 classes visited the Hackney School of Food to learn how to make paella as part of their topic work on Spain. They were such good listeners and excellent chefs, and commended by the staff there. Thank you to all the staff and to the many parent volunteers who made these trips possible!

Today was NSPCC Numbers day! THANK YOU to everyone for getting into the spirit and dressing up! There were some fabulous t-shirt designs, lots of dominoes and dice, Rubik cubes, clocks, calculators, as well as lots of home-made maths puzzles. Thank you also for the donations that will be sent directly to the NSPCC to support vital services like 'Speak out, Stay safe' and Childline. We have raised more than £350! The children have enjoyed a day of Maths puzzles, games and problems, and especially the TTime Tables RockStar competition to be the best TTRS individual player and best TTRS class! Winners will be announced in assemblies next week. Thank you to Emma for organising us all!

Also, we are all very excited for next week as it is 'Creative week'. The theme this year is 'Robots: How is the World Changing?' The world is changing through advances in technology, engineering, and artificial intelligence. Robots are increasingly used to help people in areas such as healthcare, transport, space exploration, and industry. The children in each year group will be focussing on one thing e.g.: Printmaking & Painting in Nursery, 2D Robots in Reception, 3D robots in Y1, junk-modelling robots in Y2, Robot animals in Y3, Futuristic cityscapes in Y4 and Y5 and robot animation and film in Y6. The children will then produce pieces of artwork based on their specific area throughout the week. For those who are new to Millfields this year, all of the work produced during this week - something from every child, will form an exhibition that parents are invited to visit. Our Art Exhibition will be ready for you all to see on Wednesday 25th February from 4pm-7pm - save the date and look out for more information via email and text about how to book a ticket for the sell-out event! We will also mark 'Safer Internet Day' on Tuesday 10th February and Children's Mental Health Day that will involve an activity linked with our creative week work, as well as completing a questionnaire, next week on Friday 13th February.

E.g.: Meeting her best friend was pure serendipity

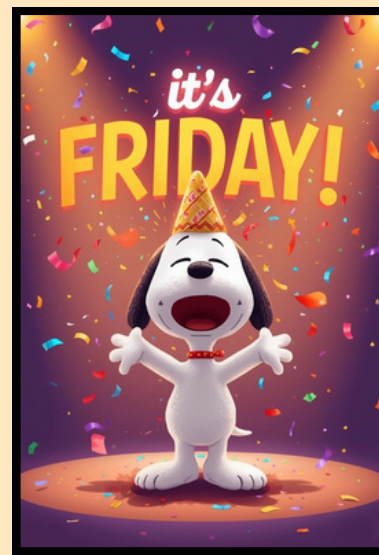


This word was invented by the English writer and politician Horace Walpole and it was inspired by a Persian fairy tale about lucky discoveries
