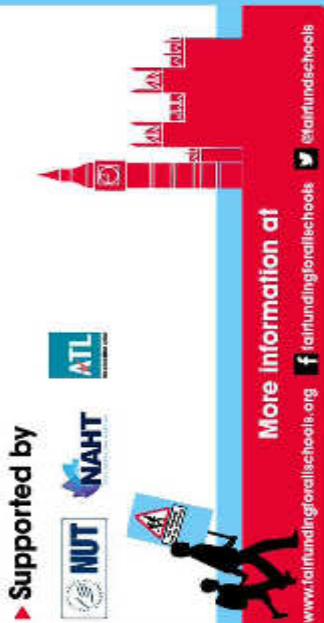
London Fields junior parkrun,
