The children all seem happy and settled in their new classes with their new teachers and they have quickly learnt new routines. They all seem to be enjoying working in new classrooms, and enjoying the first week's learning.

Each class has been revisiting behaviour for learning expectations –supporting and actively listening to each other, discussing and explaining ideas and taking responsibility for their own learning. All classes have new names this year—they are a mixture of authors, artists, scientists and inventors. The phone can be collected at the end of the day. The phone is stored at the owners risk and school will accept no responsibility for replacing lost, stolen or damaged phones.


Lateness and Attendance procedures

If your child should arrive at school late (after the 8:50am bell) they must be marked in at the late gate. This ensures that they are marked into the register and we know they are here in case of evacuation etc. The late gate is through the door near the bottom hall. Please do not enter through the school office unless very late as your child may not be marked present. Please note: no parent/carer may enter the school due to safeguarding procedures. Children will need to make their own way from the late gate to their classrooms.

If your child is unable to attend school please ensure you leave a message on the school attendance line by 8:15am on the first day of absence. This is a 24 hour message

service. (Option 1 on the automated phone message) Please clearly state your child's name, class, reason for their absence and when they can be expected to return to school. We operate a first day of absence calling system whereby if your child is absent and we haven't been notified, we will call you to ask for an explanation.

It is our duty as a school to ensure good attendance of all pupils. Any children whose attendance or punctuality is of concern will be referred to the Hackney Learning Trust Attendance Officer for further support. Millfields School attendance has always been very good and we would like to thank you all for your support in ensuring your child attends school regularly and punctually.
