All children in Year 5 have been learning chess over the year and we now have some very good players ready to play in more tournaments..

Also this week, Reception and Nursery children were treated to a ‘Cowboys and Indian’ themed Drama workshop. The children all thoroughly enjoyed the experience and we certainly have some budding performers in the Early Years!

Yesterday, we were visited by the Hackney Learning Trust Spanish Award Assessment team –this is an award for schools who have outstanding practice in the teaching of languages, especially Spanish. Belen presented lots of evidence and was observed teaching, pupils and staff were interviewed . The assessors were impressed with the level of engagement and enjoyment shown in lessons and also by progress and attainment of pupils learning Spanish and by some of the children's’ accents! A huge well done to Belen as we have achieved the Bronze Award, with a recommendation to apply for the Silver Award very early in the new academic year! Brilliant news!

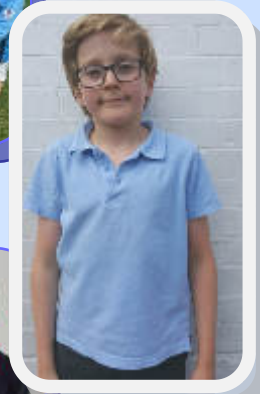
Saturday 3rd June

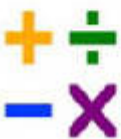
