Learning at Millfields



We are already at the end of another week - time seems to be flying by! We welcomed back the children and parents of Hutchins Class yesterday and learnt that they enjoyed learning at home but we were so happy to be back in their own classroom again!

Thank you for your understanding and patience with school photos that were taken again yesterday! Fingers-crossed, that they have taken some good

ones this time!

Across the school, the children have all been really busy in class this week as they have been beginning their classwork on Black History Month activities. In Year 3 and Year 4, classes took part in 'Black History: A Celebration' workshops - learning about key figures including Olaudah Equiano, Walter Tull, Sam King and Baroness Scotland. In Year 5 and 6, 'Her-Story' workshops focussed on the struggles

and achievements of historic and contemporary black women from the past 250 years including abolitionist Mary Prince and sculptor Augusta Savage, alongside the better-known Rosa Parks and Sojourner Truth. The children learnt about how the actions of women, from Africa and the Caribbean, to America and England, have shaped our history; or should we say, 'her-story'!

Next week, all classes will focus on a black history text in their Literacy lessons, and will be sharing

some of their work in our online Black History celebration event at the end of this half term.

Please also remember that the last day of half term is non-uniform day. This half term, we will be asking all children and staff to wear something red and will also be collecting $\pounds 1$ donations at the gate for 'Show Racism the Red Card'.
